## 6. New Business

### a. Open floor for parents discussion

- i. Does the board support the feasibility of an above ground pool in Jackson?  
Network with the Stingrays community and put feelers out for where we might be able to do this and who would be willing to support it. Phase one: Is there a warehouse or an existing piece of land where this could happen?
- ii. Phase two would be to fully flush out the costs and determine feasibility from that standpoint.

### b. Fundraising

#### i. Old Bills

#### iii. Possible fundraiser committee
