5. Old Business

- Recap of Fall Meet
 - i. Rawlins. 7 swimmers, 1 coach. Unique format.
 - ii. Intrasquad. 96 swimmers, lots of coaches, went really well. Lots of kids got personal bests. Financially, beneficial for the club. Lots of new volunteers, so a great learning opportunity before an away meet.
 - iii. Spook Splash Idaho Falls. 52 swimmers. 5 coaches. Really positive experience for everyone, lots of personal bests and state times. Relays were swam first, which was a nice change.

Maybe separate the raffle from the silent auction and make the raffle more kid-focused. Silent auction raised around \$4000 and the raffle around \$1200. Haven't gotten the numbers yet for the pizza revenue. Probably close to \$7000 for the event, which is fantastic.

 - Nora's is a potential location for a future event, similar to Handfire. They reached out to the team.
